The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Rog Rogers at 3:00 p.m. A roll call was given and present at call was Councilmember Greg Rensberger, Councilmember Calvin Cowen, Councilmember James Waddell, Councilmember Shirley Clopton and Mayor Rog Rogers. Also present at Call was Town Administrator Cameron Fant and Chief Carl Long.

In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of this meeting was submitted by e-mail to the Spartanburg Herald-Journal and the Greer Citizen on October 25, 2020. The agenda was posted on the front door of the Duncan Police Department and Town Hall on October 25, 2020. The agenda was also uploaded to the Town of Duncan Website on October 25, 2020.

Next Mayor Rogers led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

After that Mayor Rogers made a Motion to Amend the Agenda to include Resolution # R-20201026-01, a Resolution authorizing the Town Administrator to purchase a sewer easement from Carolyn Lindsey at a cost of \$5,000 for a sewer line and pump station at 446 Edwards Road Lyman, SC. A Second was made by Councilmember Clopton. The Vote to Amend the Agenda to include Resolution # R-20201026-01 passed 5-0.

Next Mayor Rogers called Town Administrator Cameron Fant to the Floor for Resolution # R-20201026-01, a Resolution authorizing the Town Administrator to purchase a sewer easement from Carolyn Lindsey at a cost of \$5,000 for a sewer line and pump station at 446 Edwards Road Lyman, SC. Fant took the Floor and told Council that the Town of Duncan as well as the Town of Lyman and two developers had been working on a plan to run a sewer line down Edwards Road to tie into a big sewer line that Lyman had on Wade Hampton Boulevard. Fant said that this sewer line would open up many acres of property in Duncan, Lyman and unincorporated Spartanburg County for sewer. Fant said that currently Duncan had a developer working on a 250 plus subdivision as well as a possible apartment complex that had to have this sewer line to work. Fant said that Duncan would only have to pay for the easement at a cost of \$5,000. Fant said the entire system would cost over \$300,000. Fant said that cost would be split among the developers and the Town of Lyman. Fant said once the system was up and running it would be transferred to the Town of Lyman. After that Fant answered a couple various questions from Council. Next Mayor Rogers made a Motion to approve Resolution # R-20201026-01. His Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Clopton. The Vote to approve

Resolution # R-20201026-01, a Resolution authorizing the Town Administrator to purchase a sewer easement from Carolyn Lindsey at a cost of \$5,000 for a sewer line and pump station at 446 Edwards Road Lyman, SC passed 5-0.

At approximately 3:25 p.m. Mayor Rogers made asked for a Motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. A Motion was made by Councilmember Clopton and her Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Waddell. The Vote to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter passed 5-0.

At approximately 4:42 p.m. Mayor Rogers asked for a Motion to come out of an Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter. A Motion was made by Councilmember Rensberger and his Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Clopton. The Vote to come out of Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter passed 5-0.

No action was taken during the Executive Session.

At approximately 4:43 p.m. Mayor Rogers asked for a Motion to close the meeting. A Motion to close the meeting was made by Councilmember Rensberger. His Motion was Seconded by Councilmember Clopton. The Vote to close the meeting passed 5-0.
