The Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Shirley Clopton at 4:30 p.m. A roll call was given and present at call was Mayor Shirley Clopton, Councilmember Alicia Fulghum, Councilmember James Waddell, Councilmember Calvin Cowen and Councilmember Greg Rensberger. Also in attendance was Town Administrator Cameron Fant.

In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, notice of this meeting was submitted by e-mail to the Spartanburg Herald-Journal and the Greer Citizen on May 11, 2023. The agenda was posted on the front door of the Duncan Police Department and at Town Hall on May 11, 2023. The agenda was also uploaded to the Town of Duncan Website on the town digital sign on May 11, 2023. Included on the agenda was the toll-free call-in number and a statement encouraging people to attend the meeting via the toll-free call-in number as an option to attending the meeting in person.

Mayor Shirley Clopton led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

At approximately 4:32 Mayor Clopton asked for a Motion to go into an Executive Session to discuss a Personnel Matter. A Motion was made by Councilmember Cowen and his Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Fulghum. The Vote to go into Executive Session to discuss a Personnel Matter passed 5-0.

At approximately 5:08 Mayor Clopton asked for a Motion to come out of an Executive Session to discuss a Personnel Matter. A Motion was made by Councilmember Rensberger and his Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Fulghum. The Vote to come out of an Executive Session to discuss a Personnel Matter passed 5-0.

No vote was taken during the Executive Session.

After coming out of Executive Session and back into the Special Call Council Meeting, Mayor Clopton asked for a Motion to accept Police Chief Shandrell Holcombe's letter of resignation and agree to his requested severance package and then to appoint Terry Lane as the Interim Police Chief for the Duncan Police Department. A Motion was made by Councilmember Cowen and his Motion was followed by a Second from Councilmember Rensberger. The Vote to approve this Motion passed 5-0.

Then at approximately 5:10 Mayor Clopton asked for a Motion to close the special call meeting. A Motion was made by Councilmember Fulghum and her Motion was followed by a Second from Mayor Clopton. The Vote to close the meeting passed 5-0.
